

which is on the UNESCO list of World Heritage, has come until today almost untouched.

In Stone Town which has labyrinth-like narrow streets adorned with peeled away colored stone houses, influence of Arab culture is intense. What is indispensable for stone houses

that gave the town its name is carved wooden doors. The doors that blended with world's famous Indian, Arab and African culture and differ according to the ethnic origin of the inhabitants, make you feel like in a beautiful canvas.

One of the most enjoyable activities in Zanzibar today is to visit the spice gardens. You get to know hundreds of kinds of spice tree during a few hours of sightseeing so much so that your nose cannot smell and your tongue cannot taste the difference
